- * Temperature Checks by our Nursing Staff
- * Graduate and TWO guests/wristband worn for admission of guests
- * All attendees must wear a mask at all times
- * Participants will be socially distanced at all times
- * Bleacher seating for guests will be socially distanced
- * All graduates must be properly dressed for graduation.

 - * No shorts or sneakers
 - * Female graduates can only wear flats or wedges on the field (no heels)
- * Once the event has concluded, all attendees must leave the field immediately.
