Title I Services serve all students at all academic levels. There is tutoring available for Math and Science, and for all Advanced Placement courses, which include AP Literature and Composition, AP Calculus, AP Spanish, and AP Biology. Additionally, the high school's instructional coaches are available for enrichment daily. Students can sign up with Ms. Abulmagd or Mrs. Daniel for extra help.

English/Language Arts

Students at the high school take a thematic approach to literacy. Students read a variety of genres and apply critical reading skills to the texts they are working on in class. The curriculum is set up so that students are often learning about the same time period in ELA and History class; thus giving students a deeper understanding of the time period from both the first person, and third person points of views.

The areas of study are as follow: Grade 9 - World Literature Grade 10- American Literature Grade 11- British Literature Grade 12 - African American Writers, Women in Literature or Shakespeare (Honors).

Teachers and coaches are available after school to help support students as needed.

Mathematics

The Abraham Clark High School Mathematics Department is working diligently to prepare students for college and a bright career. The new curriculum designed by our NJ Department of Education is modeled after the CAR model (Connected Action Roadmap), and has been out into action for Algebra I this year. The math content areas include Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra II, Probability and Statistics, and Calculus AB. These courses will lay the foundation for a strong transition into a college education. Math teachers share the same vision for the enrichment of classes. The teachers and the math coach have extra tutorina hours after school to help any student who needs help in remote learning. The Math Department is making sure that every student gets equitable access to a rigorous math instruction during this pandemic. We also place emphasis in accounting for the socioemotional aspect of the student body. We know mental health is an important part of a student's well-being and integral to building a strong future.
